Cooperation Agreement

Concluded on 12. May. 2022

between the

Herzog College located in Alon Shvut-Jerusalem-Migdal Oz, Israel represented by Harav Shlomo Brin & Harav Prof. Yehuda Brandes

("Herzog College")

and

The Emanuel Ringelblum Jewish Historical Institute ul. Tłomackie 3/5, 00–090 Warsaw, Poland represented by Director Monika Krawczyk ("Jewish Historical Institute"),

called hereinafter "Parties"

§1

1. The Parties express interest in:

- 1) academic cooperation and research in the field of Jewish history, emigration, culture and religious heritage both in Poland and Israel;
- organizing conferences on Polish-Jewish topics (such as Hasidism, Jewish education in Poland, Janusz Korczak, Sara Szenirer, etc.);
- publishing joint issues in the peer-reviewed journals Jewish History Quarterly (ZIH) and Hagut (Herzog);
- 4) organizing study tours in Poland (academic institutions, museums and archives) for researchers or educators who deal with Polish Jewry;
- 5) exchange of researchers for short periods of time;
- 6) cooperation in the areas of Jewish history and Jewish studies connected with archive research,
- 2. The Parties shall inform one another regularly about scholarly and exhibition projects of mutual interest.

- This agreement does not involve any cost or financial commitment of the parties. Each
 Party is responsible for their expenses in connection with implementation of this
 agreement.
- 2. This agreement may be terminated by both sides, by one month termination notice.
- 3. This agreement shall be interpreted according to this English version. The Polish version of the agreement serves for internal purpose of Jewish Historical Institute. In case of any dispute, the parties will make best endeavours to resolve the issue amicably.
